ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. EDUCATION Applicants that are 16 years of age and over (or an eligible dual enrolled student) may apply and enroll into the college. A high school diploma from an approved agency or a GED is required for entrance to most programs. Home school students requesting admission must submit a letter of intent to home school with verified attendance reports. This student must also submit annual progress reports or final transcript from junior and senior years including the graduation date.
- 2. AGE Applicants must be at least 16 years of age to enroll. Some programs have additional age requirements.

ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES

- 1. Submit a completed application for admission and pay a \$25 non-refundable application fee.
- 2. Complete the placement exam offered by ATC or submit any and all applicable assessment scores if taken within the past five years. Official transcripts from regionally or nationally accredited post secondary institutions documenting equivalent program-level English and math course work may be used in lieu of completing the assessment. Some programs have additional requirements.
- 3. Submit an official copy of a high school transcript or GED transcript with test scores and all post secondary transcripts in an official sealed envelope to the Admissions Office.
 - 4. Complete and submit all student financial aid information.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial assistance is available to eligible students attending Atlanta Technical College from a variety of federal and state resources. Financial aid programs include Pell Grant, Work Study, HOPE Grant, HOPE Career Grant and HOPE Scholarship. Eligibility criteria include acceptance into an approved program of study, documentation of high school diploma/(GED), US Citizenship/eligible non-citizenship, and maintaining satisfactory academic progress (SAP). Students should apply for financial aid at least six weeks prior to the first day of class. Students may apply for HOPE at www.GACollege411.org and PELL at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
